SCUBY is a 4-year research project which aims to improve the **access and quality of diabetes and hypertension care** for vulnerable people in **Belgium, Slovenia and Cambodia**. In each country, our research consortium studies the potential of scaling up integrated care for these chronic diseases through co-creation with key stakeholders.

Chronic care is high on the agenda in Belgium, and concrete steps have been taken in recent years. The discussion in the field is increasingly shifting from specific pathologies towards integrated chronic care as a whole.
